DIGNITY

International Human Rights are the legal claims of persons against the state or state-like entities, guaranteed by International law, which serve to protect fundamental aspects of the human person and their dignity in times of peace and in war.

The man image of Human Rights

Every individual is a bearer of human rights. With human rights, certain values in human existence are emphasised (or some fundamental aspects of the human person). The following values are of central importance:

Equality: Human Rights apply equally to all people. This is expressed in the prohibition of discrimination. It states that everyone, regardless of gender and group affiliation, has the right to the same Human Rights and to fair legal proceedings.

Security: Man is a vulnerable psychophysical whole. He has the right to protection from physical and psychological violations of his integrity and privacy.

Freedom: Being free means the right to lead your own life as you like and to believe and express what you think. Personal freedom is limited by the equal rights of other people.

Sociability: Man is not an isolated individual, but a social, political, and cultural being. Therefore, everyone has the right, together with other people, to found communities such as a family or to organise themselves in clubs and parties and to help shape the cultural and political life of society.

Securing livelihood: Man is a being with existential basic needs for food, shelter, health, education, work, social security, etc. From this, the right of every person is derived that his basic needs are met.

These values are particularly emphasised in the human image of Human Rights. In their entirety, these claims are referred to as 'Human Dignity'.

Therefore, in summary, one can say that the purpose of Human Rights is to protect Human Dignity.

STATUS QUO

According to the International Justice Mission (IJM, Oct.2020), more than 40 million people around the world are currently living in slavery. One in four victims of modern slavery is a child. Human trafficking generates \$ 150 billion annually.

That's more than ever before in human history. The number of unreported cases is probably much higher. Ascending trend. Not counting the millions of people in refugee camps in the world and the billions in returns from the arms industry.

These are real achievements after 70 years of Human Rights!

The excessive celebration of 'Political Correctness' by so many self-confident 'Human Rights experts' has nothing to do with Human Rights work! We are currently seeing this very clearly.

These most basic Human Rights were suspended or reduced to a minimum for millions of people worldwide within two weeks.

Article 19 | Freedom of speech

Everyone has the right to freedom of opinion and expression; this right includes freedom to hold opinions without interference and to seek, receive and impart information and ideas through any media and regardless of frontiers.

Article 20 | Peaceful assembly

Everyone has the right to freedom of peaceful assembly and association.

Article 18 | Freedom of thought

Everyone has the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion;

Freedom of thought and conscience is based on freedom of opinion and expression.

Article 21 | Participation

Everyone has the right to take part in the government of his country, directly or through freely chosen representatives.

Article 12 | Privacy

No one shall be subjected to arbitrary interference with his privacy, family, home or correspondence, nor to attacks upon his honour and reputation.

Article 13 | Movement

Everyone has the right to freedom of movement and residence within the borders of each state.

OCTOBER 2020

Article 26 | Education

Everyone has the right to education....

Education shall be directed to the full development of the human personality and to the strengthening of respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms. ...

Parents have a prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be given to their children.

Article 17 | Property

Everyone has the right to own property alone as well as in association with others. No one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his property.
